

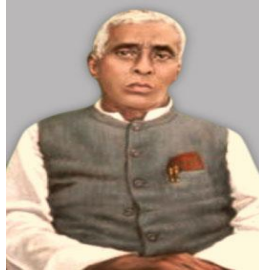

The term 'Political' is derived from the Greek word 'Polis' which means 'city' and 'state'

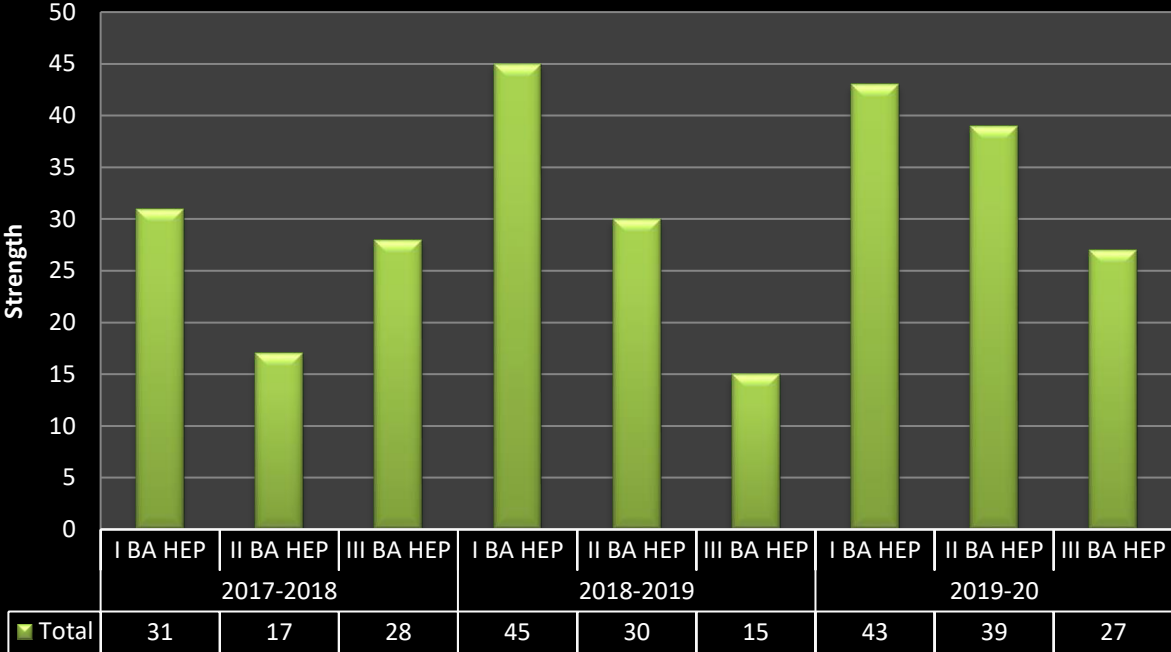

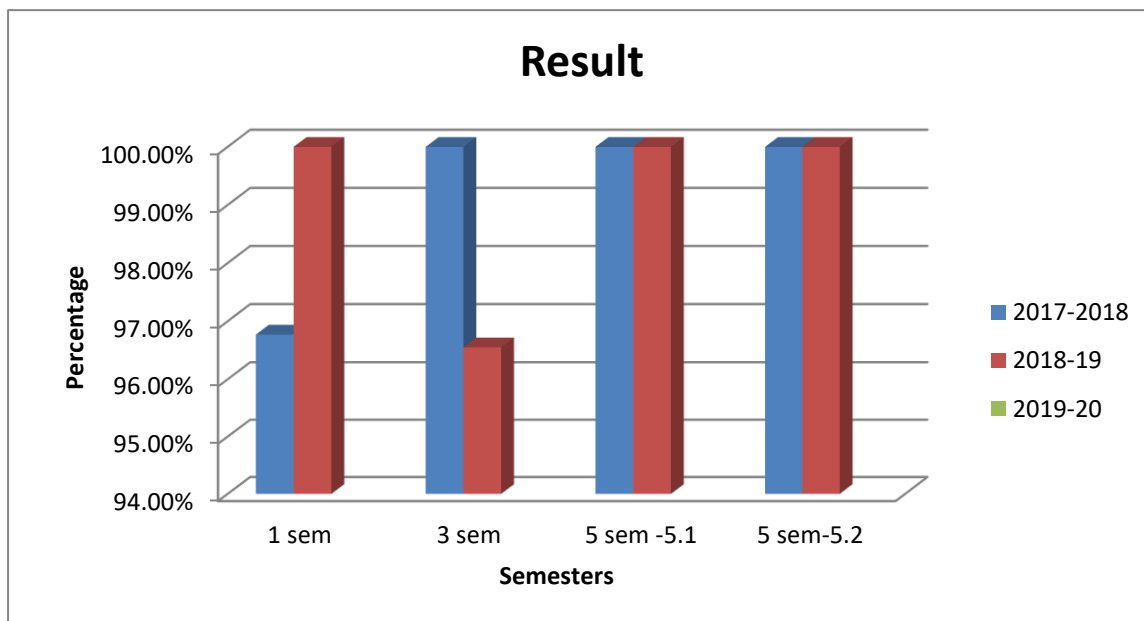

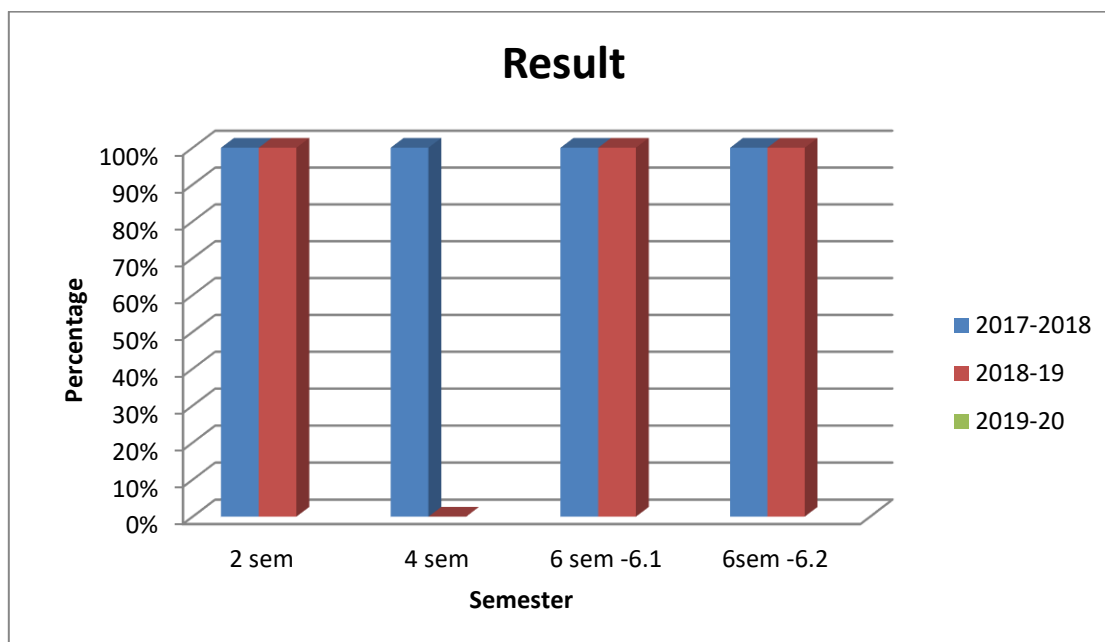
