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2017-18 STUDENT FEEDBACK AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The Rural College IQAC launched the above scheme for 2017-18. This is the most important aspect of the curriculum. The college administration relies upon student feedback and treats it as a most realistic assessment of its all-round performance and also as the most important tool available to them to maintain quality in teaching and infrastructure.

Members of the faculty visited each and every classroom to handover the feedback format individually to students asking them to record their impressions about every aspect of their studentship. The management has totally embraced the most salient objective/slogan of higher education - Quality. The management realizes that there can be no better method to rectify lacunae, oversight and negligence than the feedback. The college management and the Principal's office collects the letters that are deposited in the suggestion boxes. The academic committee under IQAC goes through these in their weekly meetings. The letters are found to contain students' impressions and their suggestions about the performances of their teachers, syllabus, time tables, bus problems, bus passes, mid-day meals, canteen facilities, quality and price of food, sports and games and their equipment, gym, stadium, drinking water facilities, library and books availability, arranging functions and opportunities for participation in events, provision of more benches in the parks, for arranging more number of trips and excursions and permission to wear the dress of their choice. Some of the above mentioned aspects had escaped the grasp of administrators. As soon as students' feedback reached the authorities no time was lost at each and every grievance rectified.

Women students' grievances are paid utmost attention and remedial action taken at once, common requests and suggestions from women students have been about rest and washrooms, more toilets, water supply and disinfectants. A special committee involving women HODs and senior students deliberate in detail and take exemplary action on these grievances, the hygiene facilities are constantly watched over by a team of women attenders.

On the suggestions and requests of women students the opportunities in extracurricular activities have been enlarged, for ex: special volleyball courts have been constructed. Musical talents are encouraged by arranging music performances with accompaniments every month.
